WHAT TO BRING LIST

CLOTHING

8 pairs of white socks
6-8 white T-shirts
6-8 pairs of underwear
Athletic shoes (at least one pair for running)
Shower shoes
One (1) swimsuit

PERSONAL ITEMS

4 towels (2 must be white for display purposes)
Wash cloths are optional
Pillow and pillowcases
Shampoo, soap, shaving items, and other toiletries
Blanket

ACADEMIC ITEMS

For all classes:
One-inch three-ring binder with dividers
Notebook paper
Pens and pencils
Book bag
For Geometry students: Protractor, Compass, and Graphing Calculator (optional)
For Algebra II students: Graph Paper and Graphing Calculator (optional)
For College Experience students: Graphing Calculator (optional)
For Chemistry students: Graphing Calculator (required)
For Spanish 1 & 2: Spanish/English Dictionary
For Photography: Personal Digital Camera (optional)
For English students: Dictionary (to be kept in dorm room for study hall)

NOTE: Cell phones and Wi-Fi capable devices are NOT permitted during the Summer Program.

OTHER

Footlocker – must have a lock
Desk Lamp
12 coat hangers
2 Nalgene-style water bottles
Fan (optional) – up to 16” with a protective guard
Broom/dust pan
All-purpose cleaner spray and paper towels
Extension cord

Lacrosse stick and gloves
Tennis racket

High Adventure Gear List

Cadets participating in High Adventure will need the following items in addition to the standard issue:

Sleeping Bag

Sleeping Pad (optional)

Backpack – large enough to hold water bottles, set of extra clothes & climbing harness/extra gear.

Water shoes - sandals are fine as long as they strap to the feet (flip-flops unacceptable for outdoor activities)

Light jacket/windbreaker – mornings and evenings can be cool.

Baseball cap

Inexpensive sunglasses w/strap (optional/recommended)

Sunscreen – several tubes to last the month.

Insect repellent

Flashlight

Camouflage utility trousers (available at HMA Quartermaster)

The cadet may bring other outdoor equipment (hiking boots, compass, camp pillows, etc.), but please leave all *lighters, matches, knives, multi-tools*, etc. at home as they are not authorized items on campus.

Optional: MP3 player (*without Internet capability*) or personal CD player
